DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The addition of adjuvants to some pesticides and/or fertilizers and their tank mixes may cause phytotoxicity to the foliage and plant tissue. Before using Spray-Put™, the applicator must have experience with the pesticide combination, including Spray-Put™, or must have conducted a phytotoxicity test.

USE RATES

0.25%–0.50% v/v (2–4 pints) of Spray-Put™ per 100 gallons of spray solution.

MIXING

Fill the spray tank with at least 50% of the desired finished carrier volume. **Do not** pre-mix Spray-Put™ in a mixing vessel or inductor. While the carrier is agitating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

1. Compatibility agent and/or antifoam, if needed
2. AMS, dry formulations (WP, DF, WDG, SP), and dry drift retardants
3. Dry soluble and suspension fertilizers / micronutrients

4. Liquid drift retardants and flowable formulations (F & FL)
5. Liquid concentrates, suspension concentrates, microencapsulated and capsule suspension (LC, SC, ME, CS)
6. Emulsifiable concentrates (E, EL or EC)
7. Solutions and soluble liquids (S or SL)
8. Liquid micronutrients and fertilizers
9. Water conditioners and other adjuvants (COC, HSOC, MSO, NIS)
10. Finish filling to desired spray volume level and continue agitation

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Keep containers sealed when not in use. Store in original container only.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
